## DEPUTY MAKES "MOST WANTED" ARREST ON WAY TO WORK

PITTSBURGH, PA – Sheriff William P. Mullen announces the apprehension of Anthony Wallace, 57 years of age from the Lincoln-Lemington neighborhood of Pittsburgh. Wallace was wanted on two bench warrants due to a violation of his probation/parole regarding a 1983 rape conviction, which he is register as a sexual offender for life and a December 2016 DUI. The violation of probation/parole was due to a May 2017 DUI case. Deputies went to Wallace's last known address, where the landlord stated he was no longer a resident. Since he was no longer living at the registered address, deputies charged Wallace with Failure to Comply With Registration of Sexual Offender Requirements on June 13th and have been searching for him since.

This morning, a sheriff's deputy who was familiar with Wallace's case was on his way to work and saw a man resembling Wallace walking up the 1400 block of Penn Avenue in Wilkesburg. Since the man was walking in the opposite direction and the deputy only got a brief glimpse of the man's face, he turned around, parked his vehicle and approached this man. The deputy asked if he was Anthony Wallace, to which the man stated he was not. Upon asking for identification and the man stating he had none on him, he finally admitted to being Anthony Wallace. By this time, Wilkesburg Police and another sheriff's deputy were able to provide backup support. Wallace was taken into custody and transported to the Allegheny County Jail. Upon lodging at the jail due to the outstanding warrants, Wallace will await arraignment on the new Megan's Law Violation charges.
