## **MEGAN'S LAW VIOLATOR SURRENDERS IN ALIQUIPPA**

PITTSBURGH, PA – Sheriff William P. Mullen announces the apprehension of Jamal Tompkins, 28 years of age, originally from West Mifflin.

Tompkins was wanted on three criminal bench warrants issued for a Violation of Probation/Parole. Due to a 2011 conviction of Sexual Assault and Corruption of Minors, Tompkins was required to register as a sexual offender. Deputies attempted to locate Tompkins on the probation/parole violation regarding the 2011 conviction, as well as a 2010 guilty plea to Manufacture/Deliver/Possession with Intent to Manufacture or Deliver. While searching for Tompkins, they discovered that he was no longer residing at his registered address and deputies obtained a third warrant for Failure to Comply with Registration of Sexual Offenders Requirements.

This morning, deputies received information via anonymous tip through the Sheriff's Office website that Tompkins was staying in the Valley Terrace Apartment Complex in Aliquippa, PA. The tipster provided information regarding the fugitive's associates and their vehicles, which led deputies to the parking lot of this complex. Upon locating the vehicle, deputies were able to make contact with Tompkins' girlfriend who convinced Tompkins to surrender himself to deputies at the Aliquippa Police Department. At 12:45PM, Tompkins arrived at the police department and was taken into custody without incident. Tompkins has been transported to Allegheny County Jail, where he will be lodged on his probation/parole violations, as well as await arraignment on his Megan's Law violation.

Sheriff Mullen would like to thank the anonymous tipster and the public as a whole for their continued support by providing such information, deputies have been very successful in expediting the execution of warrants of both criminal and non-support fugitives.
