WARRANT SWEEP YIELDS TWENTY ARRESTS IN McKEESPORT

PITTSBURGH, PA – This morning, the Allegheny County Sheriff's Office, in cooperation with FBI-Pittsburgh and the City of McKeesport Police, saturated the McKeesport area in search of wanted fugitives. By the afternoon, deputies had twenty fugitives in custody on an array of warrants, including both criminal and child support.

While executing a bench warrant at residence in the 1700 block of Abraham Street, deputies viewed a firearm and suspected heroin in open view. Upon requesting and obtaining a search warrant for the property, deputies would eventually recover over seventy bricks of suspected heroin labeled "BLU" in blue ink and approximately five more bricks labeled with a dragon in green ink. The search also uncovered two fully loaded firearms; an iridescent Sig Sauer P938 9mm and a Sar Arms B6P 9mm.

Additionally, deputies seized a Glock 42 and suspected crack cocaine while executing a warrant in the 1300 block of Maple Street, also in McKeesport.

Sheriff Mullen would like to thank both agencies for their cooperation and assistance during today's detail. The success of warrant sweeps is founded on the teamwork displayed this morning.
