## **BRADDOCK SHOOTING SUSPECT ARRESTED BY DEPUTIES IN CARRICK**

PITTSBURGH, PA – Sheriff William P. Mullen announces the apprehension of Dion Parker, 22 years of age from Braddock. Parker was wanted as a suspect in an overnight shooting that occurred in Braddock around 2:45AM. Due to these charges, Parker had violated the terms of his probation/parole regarding prior cases to which he pled guilty. The first was from a 2015 incident where he was arrested while attempting to sell 250 stamp bags of heroin and the second involved forgery charges from last year.

Today, sheriff's deputies developed information that Parker was in and around the Brownsville Road area of Carrick, as his mother resides in this neighborhood of the city. At around 1PM, deputies located the mother's address in the 1600 block of Concordia Street, where they announced themselves and were met by Parker's mother. Upon searching the residence and numerous tenants, deputies found Parker in an upstairs bedroom where he was taken into custody without incident.

Parker was transported to the Allegheny County Police Headquarters for questioning regarding the early morning shooting. Upon conclusion of his interview, Parker will be lodged on his violations of probation/parole at the Allegheny County Jail. Additionally, he will await arraignment on new charges stemming from the shooting.
