MEGAN'S LAW VIOLATOR & SISTER ARRESTED IN MT. OLIVER

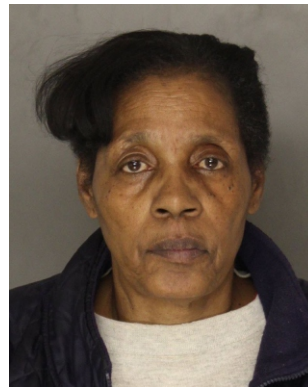
PITTSBURGH, PA – Sheriff William P. Mullen announces the apprehension of Nelson Diggs, 53 years of age, originally from McKeesport. Diggs was wanted on three warrants stemming from Failure to Comply with Registration of Sexual Offender Requirements. In fact, one of the violations was due to Diggs providing an address to the State Police, which does not exist.

Last evening, deputies discovered information that Diggs was staying in the Mt. Oliver area with his sister, Cheryl Awkward. Oddly enough, the boyfriend, who the two were believed to be staying with, had a Protection From Abuse (PFA) order against Awkward. The information developed by deputies placed the two at Awkward's boyfriend's apartment in Mt. Oliver. Upon locating the address, deputies made contact with a tenant, who was believed to be the boyfriend of Diggs' sister. After speaking with this man, he explained that Awkward and her brother were in the apartment, as well. Deputies located Diggs and took him into custody without incident. Additionally, Awkward was taken into custody for the violation of the aforementioned PFA.

Both Awkward and Diggs were transported to Allegheny County Jail, where they were lodged on their respective warrants. Diggs could face future charges regarding Failure to Comply with Registration.
