MULTIPLE-WARRANT FUGITIVE ARRESTED IN POSSESSION OF FIREARM

PITTSBURGH, PA – The Allegheny County Sheriff's Office announces the apprehension of Archie Lee Williams, Jr., 21 years of age from Wilkinsburg. Williams was wanted on three warrants, two criminal bench warrants and a family warrant. The criminal bench warrants, one from Allegheny and the other from Westmoreland Counties, carried an array of charges including Receiving Stolen Property, Firearms Not to Be Carried w/o License, Possession of Firearm Prohibited and False Identification to Law Enforcement. All three warrants were issued due to failure to appear at the respective hearings/conferences for the aforementioned criminal charges and family division case.

Deputies had received information that Williams was dating a female, who lived in the 500 block of Talbot Street in Braddock. Furthermore, it was believed that Williams had moved in and was now living at this address, too.

Around 8:30AM, sheriff's deputies, with the assistance of the US Marshals, arrived at the address and were met by Williams' girlfriend, upon announcing themselves. She stated that Williams was staying at the address and could be

found sleeping in a bedroom. Deputies entered the bedroom to find Williams asleep, as the girlfriend cited. Williams was awakened and taken into custody, without incident. While detaining the fugitive, deputies noticed a fully loaded Springfield XD-S, Semi-Automatic .45 ACP, along with suspected crack cocaine separated for distribution and a small amount of marijuana.

Williams was transported to the Allegheny County Jail, where he will be lodged on his three warrants. Additionally, he will be arraigned on new charges regarding the firearm and drugs, as Williams is a convicted felon who is prohibited from possessing a firearm.
