ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW this 18th day of June 2020, due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the emergency Orders of this Court, CDC, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and other guidance limiting public meetings and setting thresholds of public gatherings, it is hereby ORDERED, JUDGED AND DECREED that the August 3, 2020 Sheriff sale of real estate and all such monthly public sales thereafter shall be conducted virtually through video conferencing technology or live streaming. The Allegheny County Sheriff's Office shall provide for up to twenty-five persons to participate in person with physical distancing in the Gold Room in the Allegheny County Courthouse or other large courtroom.

The Sheriff's Office shall publish this Order twice in each the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and Pittsburgh Legal Journal, provide notice of the virtual sale in revised handbills, and publish this Order on its website and social media platforms.

The Sheriff's Office shall publish information as to the conditions of sale, including registration for bidding and participation in the virtual sale in its regular weekly sales advertisements and on its website.
