MAN WANTED FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A 14-YEAR-OLD GIRL TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Duquesne man wanted on a bench warrant as well as sexual assault charges has been taken into custody.

21-year-old Cameron Salmon has been on the run since August 2021 when his bond was revoked on a case involving a firearm. Since that time, additional charges have been filed against him including aggravated assault by City of Duquesne Police in January 2022 and a case filed in February 2022 by Allegheny County Police in which Salmon is accused of using the internet to lure a 14-year-old girl to the basement of a home in Swissvale. The girl subsequently told police that Salmon then sexually assaulted her in front of her 13-year-old friend.

Over the past 48 hours, Sheriff's detectives developed information that Salmon was at a residence on Morningside Avenue in Wilmerding. When detectives arrived at the location this morning, Salmon attempted to flee out a 2nd floor window but was stopped by a Sheriff K9. Salmon then went back into the residence and spent 15 minutes talking with detectives before he surrendered himself without incident.

Salmon was then transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
