MAN WANTED ON MULTIPLE FIREARMS WARRANTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Pittsburgh man wanted on multiple firearms warrants has been taken into custody.

28-year-old Carlos Hart failed to appear earlier this month for 2 non-jury trials involving firearms charges before Judge Anthony Mariani and is also suspected of violating probation on another case involving robbery and firearms convictions.

Earlier this week, detectives from our office developed information that Hart was inside of a residence along Collins Avenue in East Liberty. When detectives approached the residence on Wednesday, they discovered Hart in the attic. Hart initially resisted the calls from detectives to surrender himself and used an opening in the ceiling to threaten the detectives with gunfire if they tried to arrest him.

After nearly a half hour of talking with Hart, he agreed to come down from the attic and was taken into custody without further incident. A subsequent search of the attic revealed a loaded firearm after which Hart was transported to the Allegheny County Jail and will now face additional charges.
