MAN WANTED SINCE 2020 ON GUN AND DRUG CHARGES TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Braddock man on the run since 2020 has been taken into custody.

28-year-old Christopher Schrock was scheduled for trial in June 2020 on a number of counts including gun and drug charges filed by City of McKeesport Police when he forfeited his bond and failed to show up in court.

Detectives from our office developed information this past weekend that Schrock was squatting in an abandoned apartment on Kirkpatrick Street in Braddock. Detectives entered the building today and initially checked out another apartment that was completely vacant. While doing so, they heard noises coming from the apartment below and after exiting the building, they saw Schrock open a window and look out. Schrock attempted to exit the apartment 3 different ways until he was taken into custody without further incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
