KNOXVILLE MAN ARRESTED ON STATE PAROLE VIOLATION

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Knoxville man has been arrested on a state parole violation.

26-year-old Elijah Macon was also being sought on an active Common Pleas Court Family Division warrant when the state parole violation warrant was issued this week.

Detectives from our office developed information this week that Macon was inside of a residence on Rochelle Street in Knoxville. When they arrived at the residence shortly before 10:00am this morning, they received permission from the person in control of the residence to search the property. The subsequent search resulted in Macon being located in the attic of the property after which he was taken into custody without incident.

In the process of making the arrest, detectives discovered a Glock handgun that had previously been reported as stolen. Macon was transported to the Allegheny County Jail on the two warrants and will face a new firearms charge in connection with the discovery of the handgun.
