DETECTIVES ARREST MAN WANTED FOR SHOOTING AND INJURING WIFE

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that detectives arrested Kevin Crew, wanted since November 28, 2022 for shooting and injuring his wife while in a car. Crew then left his injured wife on the I-579 ramp to the Boulevard of The Allies.

Detectives developed information earlier today that Crew was in an apartment in the 7000 block of Apple Street in the City of Pittsburgh. Detectives arrived at the location just before 11:00 this morning and encountered Chelsey McIntosh, Crew's current girlfriend. McIntosh told detectives that Crew was not present and that she had not seen him for two days. McIntosh then admitted while being questioned that she had been arranging locations where Crew could stay. Detectives then located Crew in an adjacent apartment that was vacant. Crew was taken into custody without incident and detectives also recovered a 9MM handgun.

"I commend my detectives and personnel for swiftly acting on the information they developed today leading to the apprehension of this dangerous individual," said Sheriff Kraus. "The actions of this defendant represented a clear threat to the victim and the public."

In addition to the charges connected to the shooting of his wife, Crew was also wanted on a bench warrant for a case involving access device fraud and will be charged today as a person not to possess a firearm. McIntosh will be charged with hindering apprehension.
