PENN HILLS MAN CHARGED WITH SHOPPING PLAZA SHOOTING ARRESTED ON BOND VIOLATION

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Penn Hills man, facing charges in a 2021 shopping plaza shooting, has been taken into custody on a bond violation.

In October of last year, Judge Edward Borkowski issued a bench warrant for a bond violation for 49-year-old Norman Vire. Vire is charged with aggravated assault and a number of other counts connected to a December 2021 incident in which a witness says Vire fired several shots at him during a dispute in the parking lot of the Giant Eagle on Rodi Road.

This week, Sheriff's Detectives developed information that Vire was inside of a residence on Duff Road in Penn Hills. When detectives arrived at the residence earlier today and identified themselves, Vire surrendered without incident and was transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
