DETECTIVES ARREST PITTSBURGH MAN FACING AGGRAVATED ASSAULT AND FIREARMS CHARGES

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Pittsburgh man, facing several court cases, has been arrested on outstanding bench warrants.

This week detectives were able to develop information that 22-year-old Samuel Kirkland, wanted on two bench warrants concerning a probation violation and direct criminal contempt in Family Division, was located at an address in Uniontown.

In addition to the bench warrants, Kirkland has two active cases in Allegheny County, one involving aggravated assault in McKeesport from September of 2022 and the other involving firearms charges including theft of a handgun in the City of Pittsburgh from December 2022. Additionally, Kirkland is facing charges of assault, theft and firearms violations in Mercer County connected to an incident last month.

Earlier today, detectives from our office, accompanied by the Pennsylvania State Police, responded to an address on Greenpoint Circle in Uniontown. After knocking on the door and identifying themselves, Kirkland appeared in the doorway and was taken into custody without incident and subsequently transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
