PITTSBURGH MAN WANTED ON THREE BENCH WARRANTS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Pittsburgh man facing 3 bench warrants has been taken into custody.

28-year-old Troy Royster, from the Homewood section of Pittsburgh, pleaded guilty in March 2022 to a number of charges connected to a McKees Rocks case including aggravated assault and robbery of a motor vehicle. Additionally, Royster pleaded guilty to one count of escape and one count of flight to avoid prosecution. Judge Edward Borkowski sentenced Royster to time served plus 3 year's probation.

In October of last year, Judge Borkowski issued 3 bench warrants for Royster as the result of reported probation violations.

Over the past few days, detectives from our office developed information that Royster was known to frequent the downtown area. During the lunch hour today, detectives spotted Royster on Smithfield Street in front of Burlington and subsequently took him into custody without incident and transported him to the Allegheny County Jail.
