TEEN SHOOTING SUSPECT ARRESTED ON BENCH WARRANT

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a McKeesport teenager, charged in the 2021 shooting of a young girl, has been taken into custody on a bench warrant.

18-year-old Anthony Gibson was charged in May 2021 with exiting a vehicle near the Soft Serve and Dee-Lights ice cream shop on Miller Avenue in Clairton and firing multiple shots. Two of the shots struck a 16-year-old girl in the back and leg and she was eventually taken to a hospital for treatment of those wounds. Gibson, who was 16 at the time of the shooting, was charged as an adult with aggravated assault and firearms violations. Bail was set at \$75,000 and a bond was posted by Liberty Bail Bonds, resulting in Gibson being released from the jail shortly after his arrest. In November of last year, Gibson failed to appear for a status conference involving his case and Judge Kelly Bigley issued a bench warrant for his arrest.

This week, detectives from our office developed information that Gibson was at a residence along Faulkner Street in Sheraden. Detectives arrived at the residence late last night and were able to apprehend Gibson without incident. As they were taking Gibson into custody, detectives found a Glock handgun and, as a result, Gibson will face additional firearms violations.

Following the arrest, Gibson was transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
