WESTMORELAND COUNTY MAN WANTED FOR ABUSE OF A CORPSE IN SCOTT TOWNSHIP TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Westmoreland County man, charged earlier this week with conspiracy and abuse of a corpse in connection with a body found in Scott Township last year, has been taken into custody.

33-year-old Bradley Smith of Arnold was charged Monday by Allegheny County Police in the investigation involving the death of Lavarr Carroll in May 2022. Following the filing of the charges, the Allegheny County Police Homicide Unit provided information to our fugitive squad that Smith was located at a residence in New Kensington.

This morning detectives from our office met up with the New Kensington Police Department and proceeded to 6th Street in New Kensington where Smith was found and arrested without incident. Following the arrest, Smith was arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Frank Pallone who denied bond. Smith was then transported to the Allegheny County Jail.

In addition to the current charges, Smith also has an active warrant for violating state parole on a 2011 voluntary manslaughter conviction involving a City of Pittsburgh shooting.
