TARENTUM MAN CHARGED WITH ASSAULTING SON TAKEN INTO CUSTODY

Pittsburgh PA ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Tarentum man, facing charges of assaulting his 17-year-old son, has been taken into custody.

53-year-old Jeffrey Shutak was charged in July 2019 after police responded to a report of a domestic disturbance on Freeport Road. Shutak's son told police that his father had assaulted him and police observed a number of injuries on the son.

In June 2020, Shutak failed to show for a pre-trial conference on charges of simple assault and endangering the welfare of children and a bench warrant was issued by Judge Bicket.

Earlier today, detectives from our office located Shutak at a residence on Grantham Street in Tarentum, at which time Shutak was arrested without incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
