## PITTSBURGH MAN WANTED ON MULTIPLE WARRANTS ARRESTED IN NEW KENSINGTON

**Pittsburgh PA** ---- Sheriff Kevin M. Kraus announced today that a Pittsburgh man, facing multiple warrants, has been arrested in New Kensington.

31-year-old Tre Wingate has been a fugitive since January of this year when bench warrants were issued by Judge Howsie concerning probation violations on cases involving multiple firearms violations and fleeing a police officer. An additional bench warrant was issued in March of this year after Wingate failed to appear in family division court and Wingate is the subject of an active warrant from Pittsburgh Police charging him with aggravated assault, burglary and firearms violations.

This week, detectives from our office developed information that Wingate was in New Kensington and this morning, with assistance from the New Kensington Police Department, detectives approached an address on Victoria Avenue and eventually found Wingate hiding in a locked bathroom. Wingate complied with orders to exit the bathroom and was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Allegheny County Jail.
